

91.9 KSDB FM Sports Director

The Sports Director is in charge of distributing responsibility of sports broadcasts (for Football, Volleyball, Men's and Women's Basketball, and Baseball) to a staff of approximately 10-15 student broadcasters. Additionally, the Sports Director is required to train each broadcaster on use of the board in McCain auditorium, setting up the Tieline device, and proper on-air etiquette. It is required for the chosen Sports Director to attend a weekly meeting with the rest of the KSDB executive staff.

Job Duties:

- Properly train each broadcaster on use of Tieline device and operation of the board for sporting event broadcasts.
- Attend weekly meeting with other KSDB staff
- Communicate with the production director and other KSDB executive staff members about upcoming events and any PSAs you need to create.
- Monitor and utilize the "KSDB Sports" Twitter account
- Distribute a weekly broadcast schedule in time during class for the tri-weekly sports talk show and other sporting events the radio station is broadcasting.
- Produce liners and PSA's for sporting events and the weekly sports talk show.
- Create or delegate responsibilities to create website content after each broadcast.
- Be a good team member and communicate effectively with the rest of staff
- Help out with other KSDB events if asked.
- Communicate with Sports Information Directors with K-State athletics, Sprint Center, Bowl Game and other tournament officials to gain credentials for KSDB for sporting events.
- Communicate with approximately 15 other student broadcasters on a weekly basis through the GroupMe app.

Requirements:

- Available for at least 5 office hours in McCain Studios.
- Be able to work a total of 15 hours a week
- Knowledge of Adobe Audition is a plus.
